ORDER

Subject: Supply of commercial LPG cylinders and allocation of 20% of daily average consumption to the State Governments

Government of Punjab has approved a committee headed by the Deputy Commissioners of the districts to ensure supply of commercial LPG as per need to essential categories such as Hospitals and all Educational Institutions including Hostels. Deputy Commissioners may also on priority allot commercial LPG cylinders for marriage functions as per need and priority may be accorded to marriage of daughters. As per orders of Government of India, all the commercial establishments are non-prioritized from using commercial LPG cylinders.

2. The Committee may include Senior Superintendent of Police, Chief Medical Officer, District Education Officer, District Coordinator of Gas Companies as Members with District Food & Supplies Controller as Member Secretary. This Committee may allot LPG based on urgency and priority and also as per availability of commercial LPG stock in the district.

3. The following instructions shall be followed by the committee in this regard:

- i. The Committee meeting shall take place every day at 10.00 A.M.
- ii. The meeting shall preferably be chaired by the Deputy Commissioner. In case the Deputy Commissioner is pre-occupied, the meeting shall be chaired by an officer not below the rank of Additional Deputy Commissioner.
- iii. District Field officers of the LPG Companies shall apprise the Committee about the daily availability of commercial LPG cylinders in the district.
- iv. These daily Committee meetings shall continue till further orders by the Government.
